Snapshot of Galeon 380 Fly

Overview

The Galeon 380 Fly catches the eye with hull-length windows, aggressive lines and a large flybridge. From the aft cockpit, generous side decks and practical handrails provide easy passage to the bow sundeck. On the flybridge, the large aft sunlounge and smaller cushion next to the helm provide plenty of options for

soaking up rays. A companion can join the captain on the doublewide helm seat. Sliding glass doors open to the salon, which has an aft dinette and the galley on the helm deck.

Galeon 380 Fly running

The 380 Fly is available with twin diesel stern drives up to 370-hp each.

Galeon 380 Fly flybridge helm

The flybridge helm has a doublewide seat and notice that the wheel is offset to starboard so the companion won't encroach on the captain's ability to drive the boat.

Galeon 380 Fly cockpit

The cockpit lounge has a foldout bottom cushion and adjustable lumbar support.

Galeon 380 Fly salon

The 380 Fly's salon has a wraparound lounge to starboard and a smaller settee to port with an adjustable-height dinette table.

Galeon 380 Fly lower helm

The 380 Fly's lower helm is laid out well with the instruments on the middle level and space for electronics on the upper panel.

Galeon 380 Fly galley

Here we see the galley on the helm deck level.

Galeon 380 Fly master stateroom

The master stateroom is in the 380 Fly's bow and has a large berth with storage in the base.

Galeon 380 Fly guest cabin

Aft, the port guest cabin has space for two people plus ample storage including a hanging locker.

Galeon 380 Fly head

The head has direct access from the master stateroom and from the passageway for the aft guest cabins.
